The release function of a documentary film on NCC was held on 11 July at UMISARC Auditorium, Silver Jubilee Campus of Pondicherry University. The film was released by Virendra Kataria, Lt. Governor in the presence of Prof. (Mrs.) Chandra Krishnamurthy, Vice-Chancellor, Mr. Raajiv Yaduvanshi, Registrar, Col. M.K. Joshi, NCC Puducherry Group Commander, NCC officers and cadets. This landmark event was an apt tribute to the completion of 50 years of NCC in Puducherry on 24 January, 2014.

The film has been a collaborative effort of NCC and Pondicherry University. The basic aim of making the film in Tamil is to ensure that an average student from even the remotest villages of Puducherry and Tamil Nadu understands the role of NCC.
