Description

On March 17, 2025, the Pondicherry University Film Festival (PUFF) kickstarted at the Department of Electronic Media and Mass Communication, Pondicherry University. The movies were screened at three distinct venues: Medai (Auditorium), Thirai (Classroom 1), and Parvai (Classroom 2).
